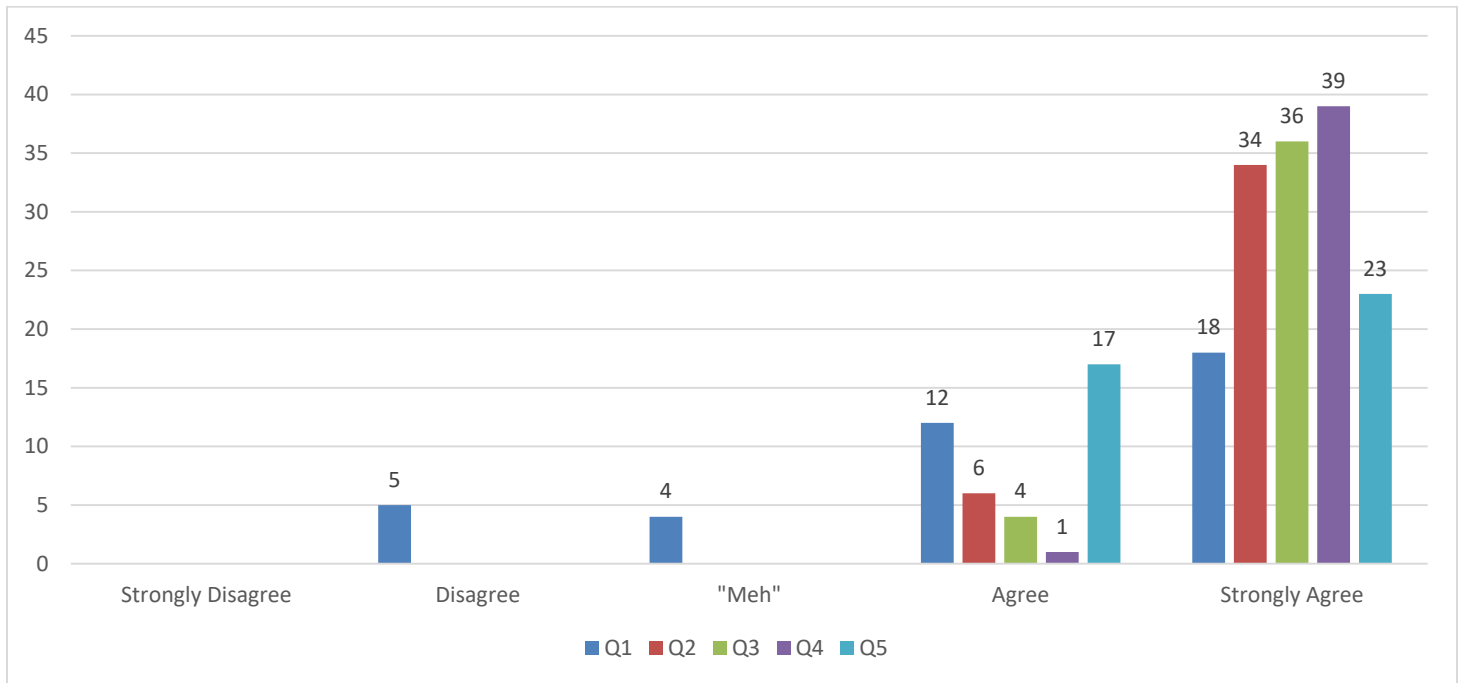




Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statements.
